Cybersecurity: Startup Vigidomaine Makes Prevention Accessible to Medium-Sized Businesses.

At a time when cyberattacks and identity theft attempts are on the rise, many small and medium-sized businesses remain insufficiently prepared. Believing they are protected by their lower visibility, they are in fact just as exposed, and often used as entry points to compromise larger organizations. In 2024, the CNIL recorded 5,629 data breaches, nearly **15 entities per day in France**. While systems have become more mature, the human factor has not: Free, Boulanger, the French Ministry of the Interior—these attacks all succeeded due to vulnerabilities linked to email usage or user account management.

In response, **Vigidomaine**, a French-based startup specializing in proactive monitoring of domain names and critical configurations, offers a solution tailored to small and medium-sized organizations, designed to **prevent incidents rather than endure** them.

A lack of awareness of security measures

Many companies invest in heavy security systems but overlook basic settings and essential configurations of their online services—elements that can nonetheless become entry points for attacks. According to field feedback collected by Vigidomaine, nearly **80% of analyzed organizations** have incorrect email configurations, exposing their identity to **impersonation and fraud risks**.

Do you see a difference between `vigidomaine.fr` and `vigidomaine.fr` ? This is an example of a technique used by attackers, one among many that we detect to prevent and neutralize malicious servers. Our innovation makes it possible to identify **typosquatting** and fraudulent use of look-alike **domain names**, monitor registered **trademarks**, and of course oversee server **cybersecurity**.

Thanks to an innovative design requiring **no installation on company systems**, we offer free plans for the smallest businesses and tailored offers for every organization, ensuring that cybersecurity is never limited by cost.

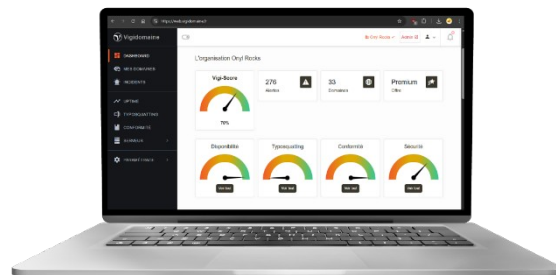
